Hawley Todd TSSF is EHMF's new foundation director. He brings 27 years of experience and commitment to healing and wholeness ministries and has been associated with EHMF since its inception in 1987. He has led retreats and healing missions in the United States and Canada and has done extensive work training and equipping healing teams for parish ministry. In the spring of 2009, he presented workshops at 2 parish health ministry conferences. The latest was National Episcopal Health Ministries conference in Omaha.

The EHMF is in the process of redesigning its web site to make information and training more readily available for groups throughout the Anglican Communion. Individuals and parishes will have greater access to in-depth mentoring and consultation for their ministries of healing. In his role as formation director, Hawley has been contacted by clergy and lay persons from a variety of locations in the United States, Canada, India and England for assistance and guidance for starting, maintaining, revitalizing, and troubleshooting healing and health ministries.
